# Financial Information

## Registration Fee:

- \$125.00 per student by June 1, 2010; \$160.00 per student from June 2 – July 1, 2010; \$190.00 per student after July 2 .

## Curriculum Fee:

- \$75.00 per student for K4-12th grade for each semester due at the time of registration or you may be billed \$20.00 per month over the 10 month billing period totaling \$200.00. The teacher may also ask you to purchase additional materials (reading books, etc.) for your student.

## Supply Fee (For K4-6):

- \$15.00 per year, per student (Due by August 31st).

## Tuition Payment Plans:

- The full year in advance is given a 10% discount, which is due by August 1st.
- The 10 month payment plan where the first payment is due on August 15th and the last payment is due on May 15th.

## Lockers:

- All Junior High and High School students are required to either purchase a locker for the price of \$80.00 or they may choose to rent a locker, which they will share with a student for \$40.00 per year. Those who decide to purchase a locker may have the use of the locker as long as they are in school.

## Athletic Teams will be required to raise additional money before playing on the team:

- \$75.00 for Basketball, \$40.00 for Volleyball, and \$35.00 Junior Patriot Basketball.

## Graduation Fees are as follows:

- \$90.00 graduation fee for Seniors.
- \$40.00 graduation fee for 8th grade.
- \$30.00 graduation fee for K5.

## Miscellaneous Information:

- There is a \$25.00 charge for any returned check. After 2 checks returned, the school will not be able to accept checks from you. You will need to pay with cash, money order, or cashier's check.
- Payments that are not made by the 1st of the following month (10 month payment plan), will be considered overdue and a late fee of \$15.00 will be added to the school bill.
- If a student's bill is not paid by the 15th of the month, he/she will not be allowed to attend class that following school day, regardless of the amount owed.
- If a student goes on vacation or is out of state for a few weeks, or months, he/she is still responsible for the school payment(s), regardless of how many days the student actually attended class.
- There will be a few additional fees during the year (ex. Intramural sports, BB tournaments for the boys, PE shorts for elementary), which we will let you know of as soon as possible.

# PARENT'S PLEDGE OF ACCEPTANCE

We, as parents who are accepting the challenge to “train up a child in the Way he should go,” do state that this training will be carried on in the home. We shall place our trust in Pacific Baptist School to extend that training more completely.

We do hereby state we have considered the curriculum, statement of faith, texts, equipment, methods, testing, counseling, discipline, and motives of the school and do pledge to make them our glad-hearted choice for the coming school year.

We do hereby pledge to be involved with our child concerning the doing of his/her homework. We pledge that, if for any reason, our child does not respond favorably to the school, we will not try to change the school to fit his needs, but will withdraw him quietly and that without delay. (Six weeks are adequate for most students. The one who has not adjusted by the end of twelve weeks should be withdrawn.)

We pledge our loyal support to the school through praying for its program and by paying the tuition payments regularly and on time.

We hereby invest authority in the school to discipline our child as necessary. We understand that discipline may include a spanking if necessary. The spanking will be carried out by the school administration. Also, we understand that a wooden paddle will be used, which we may inspect upon our request, and no more than three swats will be given to any student for any one offense. We further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child in the home as needed (Proverbs 13:24; 19:18; 22:6; 23:13-14; 29:15, 17; Col 3:20; Heb 12:6).

We understand that assessments will be made to cover damage to school property (including breakage of windows, abuse of books, etc.).

We agree to pay the tuition according to arrangements that shall be made and to conclude all required payments on or before the last day of school. We understand that tuition for one year must be paid before the pupil may continue the next year and the report cards will be withheld at the end of the school year if required payments are not made in full.
