# FINANCIAL INFORMATION

## Registration Fee:

- \$125.00 per student by June 1, 2011, \$150.00 per student by July 1, 2011, \$175.00 per student by August 1, 2011, and \$200.00 after August 1, 2011.

## Curriculum Fee:

- \$75.00 per student for K4-12th grade for each semester due at the time of registration or you may be billed \$20.00 per month over the 10 month billing period totaling \$200.00. The teacher may also ask you to purchase additional materials (reading books, etc.) for your student.

## Supply Fee (For K4-6):

- \$15.00 per year, per student (Due by August 31st). **There will be no second, third, or fourth child discounts.**

## Tuition Payment Plans:

- The full year in advance is given a **7% discount**, which is due by August 1st.
- The 10 month payment plan where the first payment is due on August 15th and the last payment is due on May 15th.

## Lockers:

- All Junior High and High School students are required to either purchase a locker for the price of \$80.00 or they may choose to rent a locker, which they will share with a student for \$40.00 per year. Those who decide to purchase a locker may have the use of the locker as long as they are in school.

## Athletic Teams will be required to raise additional money before playing on the team:

- \$75.00 for Basketball, \$40.00 for Volleyball, and \$35.00 Junior Patriot Basketball.

## Graduation Fees are as follows:

- \$90.00 graduation fee for Seniors.
- \$40.00 graduation fee for 8th grade.
- \$30.00 graduation fee for K5.

## Miscellaneous Information:

- There is a \$25.00 charge for any returned check. After 2 checks returned, the school will not be able to accept checks from you. You will need to pay with cash, money order, or cashier's check.
- Payments that are not made by the **1st of the following month (10 month payment plan)**, will be considered overdue and a late fee of **\$25.00** will be added to the school bill.
- If a student's bill is not paid by the 15th of the month, he/she will not be allowed to attend class that following school day, regardless of the amount owed.
- **NEW** **If a student's bill is not paid by the 1st of the month (13-16 days after the original due date), he/she will not be allowed to attend class the following school day, regardless of the amount owed.**
- If a student goes on vacation or is out of state for a few weeks, or months, he/she is still responsible for the school payment(s), regardless of how many days the student actually attended class.
- **There will be a few additional fees during the year** (ex. Intramural sports, BB tournaments for the boys, PE shorts for elementary boys), which we will let you know of as soon as possible.

## WHY YOUR CHILD NEEDS SHOTS

The California School Immunization Law requires that children be up-to-date on their immunizations (shots) to attend school or child care. Diseases like chickenpox, measles, and whooping cough spread quickly, so children need to be protected before they enter. Most children need booster shots before starting kindergarten. 7th grade entry requirements went into effect July 1, 1999. A varicella (chickenpox) requirement for kindergarten entry and child care attendance went into effect July 1, 2001.

## WHAT YOU WILL NEED AT REGISTRATION

You will need your child's Immunization Record. It must show the date your child was given each required shot. If you do not have an Immunization Record or your child has not received all required shots, call your doctor or local health department now for an appointment.

Review your child's Immunization Record to make sure you have a date for each shot required.

<sup>a</sup> This number includes kindergarten boosters. If your child is 4-5 years old, entry requirements are met with only 3 polio and 4 DTPs if at least one polio and one DTP dose were after your child's fourth birthday.

<sup>b</sup> For children 7-17 years old, entry requirements are met with only 3 polio and 3 DTP or DT/Td if at least one polio and DTP or DT/Td were after your child's 2nd birthday. For students age 7 years and older, pertussis immunization is not required.

<sup>c</sup> A Td booster is recommended but not required.

<sup>d</sup> One dose must be on or after the 1st birthday regardless of any doses received earlier. The Hib requirement applies only to child care children under age 4 years and 5 months.

<sup>e</sup> One dose on or after the first birthday is required for grades 1-6 and 8-12. Mumps immunization is not required for students age 7 years and older.

<sup>f</sup> Two doses of the 2-dose hepatitis B vaccine formulation along with provider documentation that the 2-dose hepatitis B vaccine formulation was used for both doses and both doses were received at age 11-15 years will also fulfill this requirement.

<sup>g</sup> If your child had chickenpox disease, ask your doctor to note it on the immunization record to meet the requirement.

<sup>h</sup> Required for children not enrolled in California schools before July 1, 2001. 1 dose required for grades K-12. For children 13-17 years old, 2 doses are needed if vaccine received after 13th birthday.

If your child's record is missing some doses, please contact your doctor or clinic now to obtain the full immunization record or any doses needed. If your child recently received immunizations and needs an immunization later in the year, he/she can be allowed to attend, provided you get the remaining doses when they become due.

Your child may be exempted from some or all immunizations by a doctor because of a medical condition. Your child may be exempted by you because of your personal or religious beliefs. Ask your school or child care provider for details.

# STUDENTS ENTERING FIRST GRADE

## PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

The Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) Program was created based on a law passed by the California State Legislature to promote the health of children and youth in California. The law states that parents are responsible to see that their children receive a health examination, regardless of income, **within 18 months prior to first grade entry or 90 days thereafter**. Furthermore, the parent must present proof to the school (Form attached) that the child received a health examination within this time period.

One out of every ten children entering first grade has a health problem unknown to the parent. When your child is examined, you will be given an explanation of the results. If treatment is recommended, you will be referred to an appropriate physician.

We urge you to ask the physician to share with us any health problems which might affect your child's ability to learn or participate in physical activities. We have enclosed the form **(REPORT OF HEALTH EXAMINATION FOR SCHOOL ENTRY - PM171A)** that needs to be completed by your doctor. Bring this signed form into the school office after your child has been examined.

If you have any questions regarding this physical for your child, please call the school office at (562) 426-5214. It is much easier to get an appointment for your child during the summer months. **Please do not wait until the last moment to schedule your child's appointment. Your child can not start school unless this examination is completed and the form is turned in to the school office.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** If your child has already had the physical during K5 and the form has been turned in to the office, please advise the school office and disregard this letter.
